Only the managers' houses were built on Alveley side. Some of the workers houses had previously been owned by Kinlet Colliery. Alveley miners lived in rented or council properties.

The Council had given £100 for the plants to be planted in the Village planters. Margaret Shaw had only claimed £85.50 so we have £14,50 of that money left. It was agreed that if she claimed more than that next time we would pay it and see if the Council would recompense the Society.
